#### **Application**

# **CRITERIA**

- A. A grade twelve student presently.
- B. Has a parent or guardian who is a member of C.U.P.E. Local 379 and has been for at least one year.
- C. Is proceeding within 18 months of being awarded the Scholarship to a recognized School of Higher Learning. The 18 months is not intended for a 'gap' year, it is in case there is a delay in achieving enrolment.
- D. Must be planning to attend a recognized School of Higher Learning.

# **APPLICATIONS**

Applications for the Scholarship must be made on or before the **15<sup>th</sup> Day of July** in each year.

- 1. The Scholarship application **must** include the following:
  - a) The completed form provided.
  - b) A letter, in the applicant's own handwriting stating to what use the writer would put the scholarship if successful, including full address & phone numbers.
  - c) Two letters of recommendation, one must be from the Principal/Vice-Principal/Teacher or Counsellor of the school the applicant is currently attending. Both must be current & originals or a screen capture.
  - d) The most recent table of marking or a screen capture.

An incomplete application will result in disqualification.

2. The applications will be submitted to CUPE Local 379's Scholarship Committee for their decision on whose recommendations will be binding.

- 3. The decision as to what constitutes a School of Higher Learning will rest entirely with the members of the Scholarship Committee.
- 4. <u>CUPE Local 379 will issue a cheque when registration receipt has been received</u> <u>from the scholarship winner.</u> e.g. Proof of payment for registration fees.
- 5. The cheque will be sent directly to the 'School of Higher Learning'.
